New Free Online Learning

Lynda.com is now available at GPL

A new online learning option is now offered at GPL. Lynda.com is an online learning site that hosts a constantly growing library of over 3,000 courses that include over 130,000 videos. Courses cover a variety of topics (including business, design, web development, and multimedia skills) and software (Microsoft Office, Adobe Creative Suite, and open source applications) that can help you pursue personal and professional goals. These courses are delivered by expert instructors and feature searchable transcripts that make it easy to find quick answers to questions.

Anyone with a GPL Evergreen Indiana library card will have access to the full collection of online tutorials.

The library has always been the place to turn to for continuing education, and the staff at

GPL is excited to give patrons another way to keep learning even when the library is closed or when they cannot make a visit.

“We offer basic computer classes, and one-on-one training sessions, but this is a great option for patrons to expand beyond what we can teach at the Library,” said librarian Valerie Holbrook. “Whether patrons are newbies or looking for more complex topics, Lynda.com really has something for everyone.”
