New art piece coming to GPL in 2018

The Greenwood Public Library celebrated its 100th year of service to our community on February 7, 2017. GPL is a thriving community hub that is stable, resilient, transformative, focused on our community, and committed to the public good.

The public art piece we want to create will be a 5' by 30' metal sculpture made of words and book titles as pictured. The silver steel will be off-set from a blue wall and dramatically backlit. The titles used in the piece will be from classic books that so many people have cherished.

This piece will highlight the importance of the Library in the community and create a beautiful showpiece that declares our purpose and mission.

The public art piece has been developed by artist Jon Racek, of Bloomington Indiana. Jon Racek is a multidisciplinary designer whose scope of expertise spans architectural, land-scape, and industrial design.

We will be working with Poynter Metal of Greenwood to fabricate and install the piece. We hope to install this artwork in early 2018.




