

HOW TO CODE WITH OZOBOT

SCREEN-FREE : HOW TO CODE WITHOUT TECHNOLOGY

You'll need a sheet of computer paper and colored markers (black, red, blue, or green)

- Step 1 Start by drawing a thick black line
- Step 2 Turn on your Ozobot by pressing the button on the side of the robot for 2 seconds until it starts to flash
- Step 3 Place the Ozobot at one end of the black line and watch it travel to the other side!
- Step 4 Want your Ozobot to do something else? Follow the color code sheet on the next page



APP & WEB-BASED CODING : HOW TO CODE WITH TECHNOLOGY

*You'll also need to check out an Apple iPad from The Studio

Ozobot App - Lets you play different types of games with one or more robots right on the tablet. The app includes three distinctive games: OzoDraw, OzoLuck, and Ozopath.

<u>OzoDraw</u> - a drawing game designed to foster creative play and interact with the robot.

OzoLuck - a social game of chance where Ozobot chooses your luck.

OzoPath - sing or dual player tile-based strategy game for Ozobot.

Ozobot Groove App - Program your Ozobot to dance to your favorite songs and music. Get started with the basic dance editor which lets you link up multiple dance moves and light colors by simply dropping them onto your song's timeline.
