

## HOW TO MAKE A BUTTON

Design, cut, pull - you're done!

- Step 1 Simply design your buttons by hand or on a computer. You can also make buttons from graphics cut from printed material like books, photos and magazines.
- Step 2 Cut out your graphics using the paper cutter or a pair of scissors. Just a reminder that our button maker makes buttons that are 1" in circumference, so you'll want to leave a little extra space around your graphic.
- Step 3 Place the front shell (sharp side DOWN) into the shallow die of the button maker. On top of the shell, place your graphic, and then a piece of the clear mylar. Swivel so the supplies are under the press and pull the lever once. The top of your button will "disappear".
- Step 4 Place the collet (back ring) of your button (sharp side UP) into the deeper die. Swivel so the back of the button is under the press and pull the lever once.
- Step 5 Pop the pin into the back of your button.
