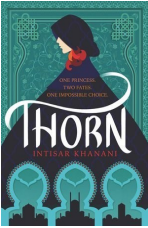

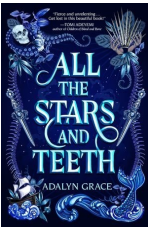
Thorn by Intisar Khanani

A betrothed princess is robbed of her identity by a mysterious sorceress before a threat against her betrothed prince compels her to make a dangerous choice.



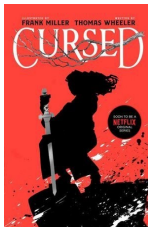
When We Were Magic by S. Gailey

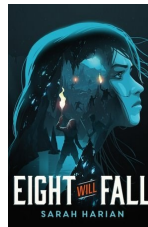
Havenfall by Sara Holland
