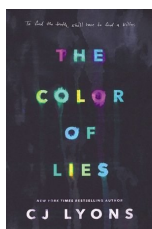


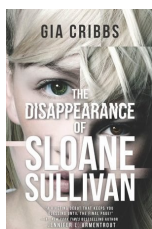
## MYSTERY &amp; THRILLER

Approaching her release from witness protection, a high schooler reunites with an old friend and considers breaking the rules, placing herself at high risk.



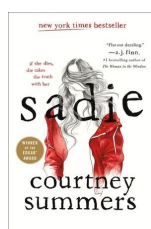
**In the Hall with the Knife**

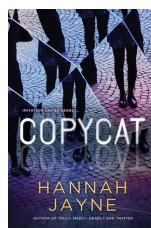
**People Like Us** by Dana Mele
